REGISTRATION TERMS

Scholarships :

The 2012 New Music Session faculty will select 4 participants (2 composers and 2 performers) who will be awarded \$550 each, based upon the excellence of their dossier. In addition, at the end of the session, a prize will be awarded to a composer to attend a free session at the Voix Nouvelles de la Fondation Royaumont (France) in September 2013. This exchange of participants is made possible through a partnership between the Domaine Forget, the Nouvel Ensemble Moderne and the Fondation Royaumont, with the support of the Ministère des Relations Internationales and the Consulat général de France à Québec. Two scholarships will be offered to a composer and a performer for New music session 2013.

2012 FEES

Students must pay their session in Canadian dollars.

1. Registration fee

A non-refundable application fee of \$65 CDN must be included with the application form.

2. Room and board fees

New Music session: August 12th to 25th 2012 / 2 weeks

\$1380 CDN for Canadian students / \$1450 CDN for international students

Please note that the application fees are not included.

Terms of payment for room/board and tuition fees

The student is required to pay 50% of the course fees upon reception of the acceptance letter. The remainder should be paid one month prior to the opening of the session. Please see <http://www.domaineforget.com/en/1/money-matters> for payment methods (Paypal, certified cheques or money orders). Failure to comply to these conditions will entail automatic withdrawal from the session.

Cancellation or modification

After the deadline, the Domaine Forget will retain \$50 per application should the student switch from one week to the other or decide to attend for a shorter period of time.

The Domaine Forget reserves the right to cancel a session if circumstances do not warrant its presentation.

Applications received after the deadline will only be considered if there is available space. The postmark will serve as proof of the date on which the application was mailed.
